To develop a framework of stakeholders,

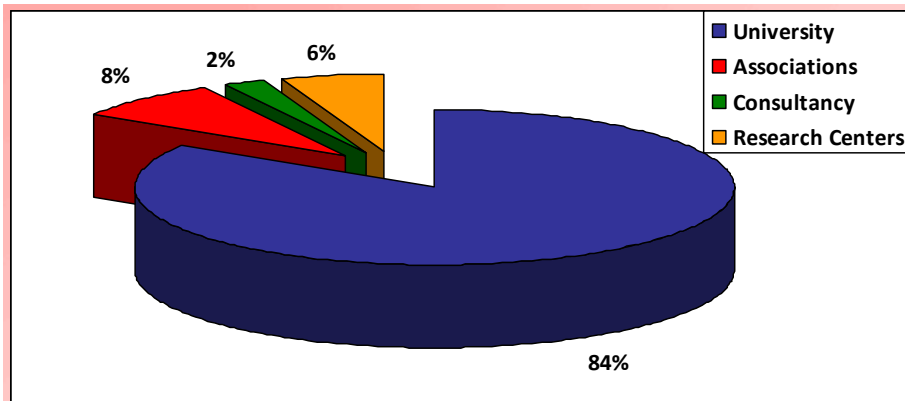
- to lead **innovation in Food studies** education and training fitting the needs of enterprises,
